Governance

The Nottingham Academy has a local 'Council', which is similar to the Governing Body of a maintained school.

This Council has three key roles in terms of the development and success of the Nottingham Academy:

1. To advise and act as a critical friend to the Executive Principal and the Heads of School of the Academy and to advise the Board of Directors of the Greenwood Dale Foundation Trust about local issues they need to consider that affect the Nottingham Academy.
2. To represent the interests of the Nottingham Academy community in the running of the Academy and to represent the Nottingham Academy in its community.
3. To provide support to the Executive Principal and Heads of School in undertaking appropriate day to day procedures that are essential to the life of the Academy, such as disciplinary and complaint procedures.

The Chairman of the Council is David Shelton, who is also Chairman of the Greenwood Dale Foundation Trust.

The Council has eleven members. These include local staff, parent and business representatives.
