You can write a response in any form you would like, we'd recommend:

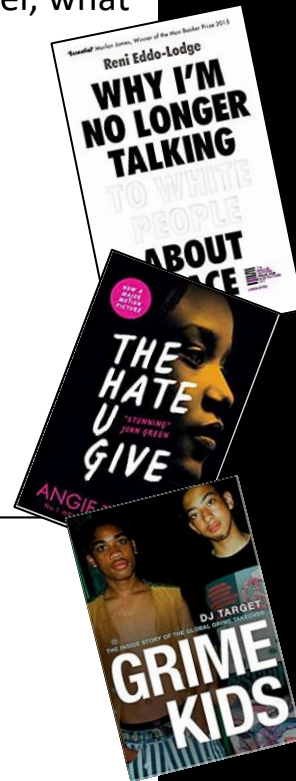
- A poem

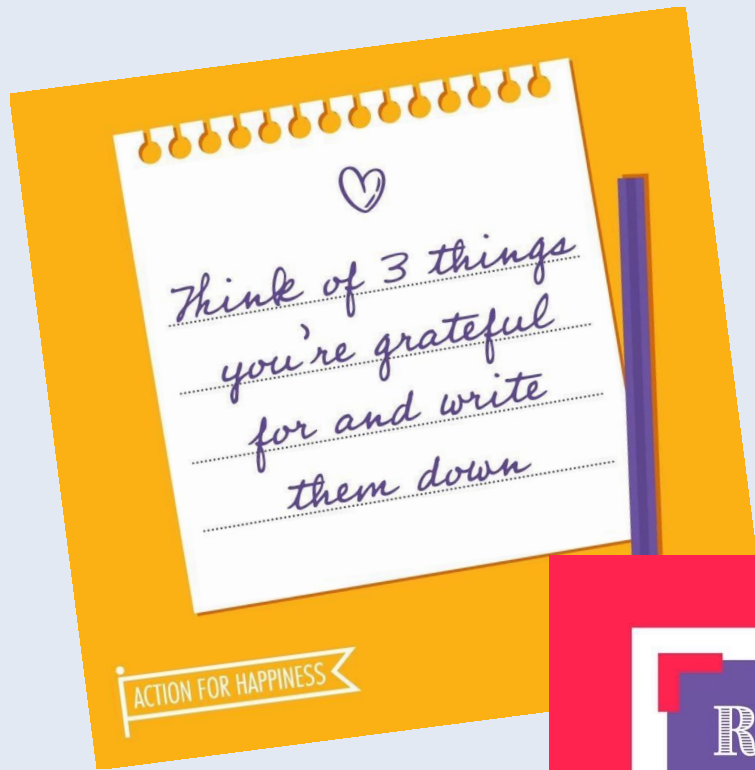

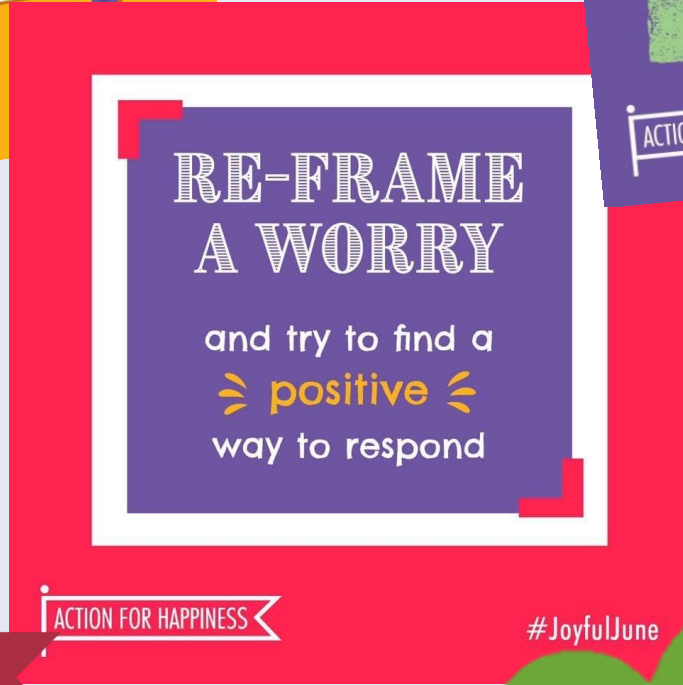

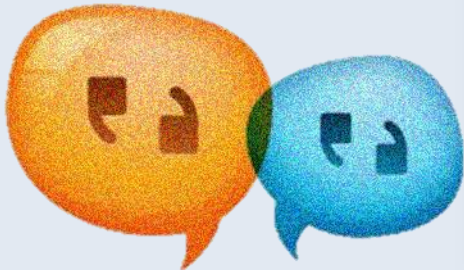
