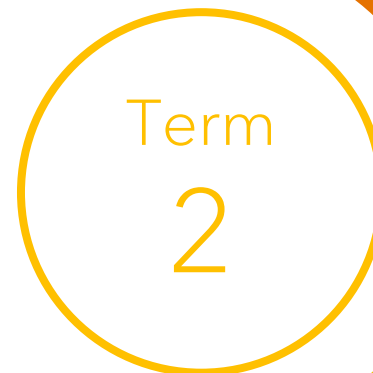
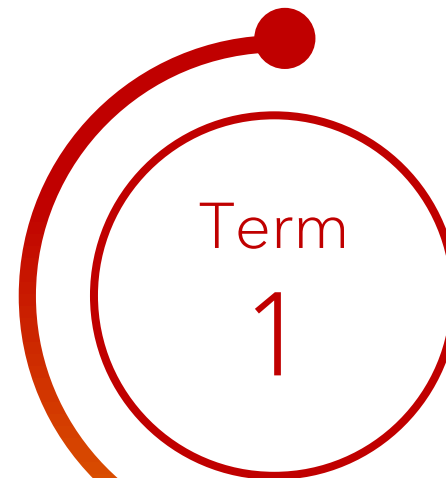


How I'll be assessed...

Final Preparations and Consolidation

During this term, students will focus on final preparations for the Unit 4 exam. They will review legislative processes, the organization of the criminal justice system, and models of criminal justice. Students will revisit forms of social control and the aims of punishment, critically assessing how different forms of punishment meet these aims. They will consolidate their knowledge of the roles and contributions of criminal justice agencies, examining their limitations and evaluating their effectiveness. This term includes intensive revision sessions, practice exams, and targeted support to ensure students are well-prepared for their final assessments.



Crime Scene to Courtroom and Crime and Punishment (Units 3 & 4)

Students will start the year by studying the roles of police, forensic experts, and legal professionals in criminal investigations. They will learn about different investigative techniques and the rights of individuals involved in investigations. Additionally, students will discuss the use of evidence in criminal cases and understand the requirements for prosecuting suspects. They will also explore the influences on criminal case outcomes, such as media and public opinion. Concurrently, students will learn about law-making processes, the organization of the criminal justice system, models of criminal justice, and forms of social control. They will discuss the aims of punishment and evaluate the effectiveness of various criminal justice agencies. This unit includes an 8-hour controlled assessment in March and prepares students for the 1.5-hour external exam in June.
