#### Ambroise Paré

# The story of the Ligatures





Paré criticised the method of cauterising the wound to stop the bleeding after an amputation.



Cauterisation was to press a red-hot iron against the stump of the limb to cook the flesh and stop the bleeding. Patients often died in agony!




Paré now tried a new method of stopping the bleeding. He tied silk thread around each of the blood vessels. This was called a ligature and stopped the bleeding. Paré had made a great discovery. But people still got infections because Paré didn't use clean thread. He did not know that germs caused disease.

He wrote a book with his discoveries called 'Works on Surgery' which was translated into many languages.


